## **How to Enter**

We reserve the right to refuse entries or transfer entrants from one section to another at any point.

**Withdrawals:** If you withdraw before entries close on Friday 2 February we will refund your entry fee less a £3 administration fee. If withdrawing during the tournament, please notify a controller in person or note it on your result slip.

**Byes:** You may take a half-point bye in any *one* of the first four rounds. Please notify us if possible on the entry form or at the beginning of the tournament.

**Rules & conditions:** The tournament will operate in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess except as otherwise indicated on this entry form or on the Kidlington Tournament website. Players entering the tournament **agree thereby to abide by these rules and the decisions of the controllers**.

**Electronic devices:** A player **must not use any electronic device** *during a game* without the controller's explicit permission. Players may keep such devices with them at the venue, but they must be fully switched off (not merely muted). They must not be carried on the person during a game but may, for example, be kept in a bag on the floor or in a coat on the back of a chair. *These rules apply at all times during playing sessions*. In particular, a player whose **mobile phone** sounds during a game will forfeit the game.

**Prizes:** Prize monies will be sent out within 7 days of the event by cheque or bank transfer. Prizes will be shared in the event of a tie.

To be eligible for an age-related prize, entrants must supply their date of birth on the form. No entrant may receive more than one individual prize, but a winner of an individual prize remains eligible for a share in the team competition prize.

Rate of Play: All moves in 90 minutes, plus 15 seconds per move increment from move 1. Any player arriving more than 30 minutes late will be deemed to have lost unless re-pairing is possible. His/her opponent, however, must expect to be paired again if another player is otherwise without a game after 30 minutes. The rate of play is subject to alteration in the case of such re-pairings.

Ratings and prizes: Ratings will be taken, where available, from the latest revision of the ECF's January 2024 rating list. If you do not have a current ECF rating, please give your most recent ECF rating or grade and any other current official rating. If you have none, please provide other evidence of your playing strength, e.g. tournament results. Please note that:

(i) Only players with a current ECF standard-play rating are eligible for rating prizes.

(ii) In the rating-limited sections, players for whom we lack rating information based on at least 10 rated games in the last 5 years can receive only half of any individual prize.

*Please also note:* it is a condition of entry that players agree to their rating information and results being published on the ECF and Kidlington websites and the <a href="Chess-Results.com">Chess-Results.com</a> website. All pairings will be made with Swiss-Manager.

**ECF Rating surcharge/Pay-to-Play fee:** Under ECF membership arrangements there will be no charge for the rating of the games of those who are ECF members at Silver level or higher, but the tournament organisers will be charged £9.00 for the rating of the games of non-members or Bronze-level members. Bronze-level ECF members who pay the surcharge will have their membership upgraded to Silver level after the tournament.

**Analysis:** A separate room will be available for analysis and discussion.
